



2nd Annual Roper Apparel & Footwear Barrel Futurity Rules



\$7,500 added money, Jessie Jaymes Trophy Buckle to average winner or fastest time on the two go-rounds. Roper Award Coats to the Top Ten in the average.

1. The 2nd Annual Roper Apparel and Footwear Futurity will be governed by our committee and their decisions will be FINAL. We reserve the right to refuse entry to any horse or individual.
2. The 2nd Annual Roper Apparel and Footwear Futurity will be held on November 21-22, 2009 at the Cam-Plex Arena, Gillette WY.
3. The Futurity is open to horses foaled in 2004 or after. Horses must not have reached the age of six by the time of the futurity. All Futurity entrants must be checked in prior to competing.
4. To be eligible for the futurity, the horse must never have competed in ANY barrel racing prior to December 1, 2008. To do so means to forfeit any and all fees paid and elimination from the futurity. Horses may have competed ANYWHERE after December 1, 2008. Horses may have been entered in other events.
5. Owners may enter more than one horse. The owner does not have to ride his/her own horse. Either male or female rider is allowed and no age limit to the rider. All riders must be designated by November 1, 2009. Should a nominated horse be sold during the course of the payment period, written authorization from the original owner must be received by Kohr Quarter Horses, LLC before horse can continue to be paid on. 6. Substitutions will be allowed due to death, injury or illness of the entered horse. Deadline for substitutions is November 1, 2009. Substitution must be made in writing along with a copy of the substituted horse's papers, or vet's affidavit of year of birth and description plus a \$50 fee and all mailed to Kohr Quarter Horses, LLC, P O Box 3475, Gillette WY 82717 307.680.5271.
7. Two electric eyes will be used.
8. If horse falls, no rerun will be granted.
9. **NOMINATION AND SUSTAINING FEES**
Total Futurity Entry Fees will be \$290.
\$100 to nominate August 1, 2009
\$100 to sustain September 1, 2009
\$90 to sustain October 1, 2009

Any payments post marked after the due date will be figured **LATE** and assessed a late fee. Late fees will be \$25 per payment missed in addition to any sustaining late fees still owed. A photocopy of both front and back of nominated horse's registration papers or a veterinarian's affidavit stating their age and description must accompany the nomination.

10. All checks for entry fees will be made payable to “Kohr Quarter Horses, LLC” and mailed to Kohr Quarter Horses, LLC, P O Box 3475, Gillette WY 82717 307.680.5271. Any insufficient fund checks received will automatically require all fees payable by cashier’s check plus \$30 per ISF check received.
11. There will be a charge of \$90 per entry fee per horse with the balance of \$200 being added to the purse. The \$90 includes administration fees, timer charges and starting fees. The division of the purse will be:
30% to the first Go-Round
30% to the second Go-Round
40% to the Fastest Average on the 2 Go-Rounds
12. There will be two go-rounds, the first go-round will be drawn and run on Saturday, November 21, 2009 and the second go will run in reverse order on Sunday, November 22, 2009.
13. The money jackpotted will be the Added Purse (\$7,500) plus \$200 for all of the fully paid up horses, whether they run or not. All late fees or drop out horse’s fees will be retained by the committee.
14. General ground rules and arena riding times will be posted at the Cam-Plex Arena Entry Office by Friday, November 20, 2009.

16. Stalls, RV hookups and shavings are available upon arrival through the stall office. Call 307-680-5271 if plan to arrive prior to Friday November 21, 2009.
17. Full dress code required: Long sleeved shirts, hats and riding shoes or boots must be worn.
18. Any knocked down barrel receives a 5 second penalty.

AMATEUR DIVISION \$500 added money, Jessie Jaymes Trophy Buckle to average winner or fastest times on the two go rounds, Roper Award Coats to top 3 in average.

1. Amateur must be a futurity entrant. An amateur entry must have never won \$1001 in barrel racing futurities prior to December 1, 2008.
2. An additional amateur entry fee of \$65 is required. \$50 will be jackpotted back and the pay off will be 50 % in each go-round. A buckle will be awarded to the fastest average times on the two go-rounds. The \$65 amateur fee is due with your last sustaining payment and must be marked on the entry form that you are an amateur entry.

ROPER TRIFECTA HIGH POINT AWARDS

HIGH POINT FUTURITY HORSE AND HIGH POINT AMATEUR RIDER: Roper award coats to each champion and reserve champion high points. Points will be tabulated from the best three of the four futurities: 5 States Breeders Futurity, Fizz Bomb Classic Futurity, ND

Barrel Futurity and the 2nd Annual Roper Apparel and Footwear Barrel Futurity. Eligible entrants must be entered in three of the four mentioned futurities for their points to count.

For the High Point Futurity Horse, points will be counted on the horse, however the same rider must ride it, making a team. Points will be distributed on the 1st and 2nd go round of each futurity, from 10-1 for the High Point Futurity Horse. All of the points from all of the futurities (the 5 States, Fizz, ND and the Roper) will be tabulated, then the points from their best three of the four futurities will be calculated and the Futurity Horse/Rider team with the most points will be awarded **The High Point Futurity Horse Roper Award Coat**. The entrant must be entered in at least three of those four futurities.

For the High Point Amateur Rider, an amateur cannot have won \$1001 lifetime in futurity competition. Points will be distributed on the 1st and 2nd go round of each futurity, from 5-1 for the High Point Amateur Rider. All of the points from all of the futurities (the 5 States, Fizz, ND and the Roper) will be tabulated, then the points from their best three futurities of the four will be calculated and the Amateur Futurity Rider with the most points will be awarded **The High Point Amateur Rider Roper Award Coat**. The entrant must be entered in at least three of those four futurities.

Barrel Racing Report Open 4D

***OPEN 4D \$500 Added each day: Saturday, November 21 and Sunday, November 22nd, 2009.
Both are NWBRA, WPRA, and RCM approved***

1. Entry fees are \$42 per entry. Pre-Entries close November 1, 2009. Entry forms are available at these websites: www.KohrQuarterHorses.com, www.erooper.com, and www.sevendown.com. Entries must be post marked by November 1, 2009 or they are counted as late entries, (\$10 per horse) Mail entry forms and appropriate fees payable to: Kohr Quarter Horses, LLC. P O Box 3475, Gillette WY 82717. All pre-entries will be drawn and posted on the websites: www.KohrQuarterHorses.com, www.erooper.com, www.sevendown.com, plus they will be posted at the entry office by 12 noon, Friday, November 20, 2009.
2. Late entries will be taken the day of with \$10 late fee per entry. All late entries will be taken up to 30 minutes before the first runner of the Open 4D. They will be drawn for immediately after entries close.

Peewee Barrels: (7 years and under day of event), Sunday, November 22nd, 2009.

1. Entry fees are \$7 per entry. No pay back and Roper Bucks to all entries. No pre entry necessary and no late fees day of event.

Youth 3D Barrel Race: Sunday, November 22nd, 2009.

1. Entry fees are \$22. The divisions are 1 second splits. There will be pay off and Jessie Jaymes Trophy Buckles to all winners in each division. No late fees day of event.
